

## **Environmental Policy - EMS002**

It is the Policy of Cavendish Networks that management and all who work for the company are committed to the care of the environment, protection of the environment and the prevention of pollution.

As part of this commitment the organisation ensures that all its activities are carried out in conformance with the relevant environmental legislation and all compliance obligations to which the organisation subscribes in relation to its environmental aspects.

Cavendish Networks seeks to minimise waste, promote recycling, and where possible, to work with suppliers who themselves have sound environmental policies.

An essential feature of the environmental management system is a commitment to improving environmental performance. This is achieved by setting a framework of annual environmental improvement objectives and targets which are regularly monitored and reviewed. The objectives and targets are publicised throughout the organisation and all staff are committed to their achievement.

In anticipation of the continuing changes to environmental standards, regulatory requirements and customers' expectations, this Policy will be implemented and maintained along with the Environmental Management System. The System will be periodically reviewed by senior management to ensure that it meets the business objectives.

In order to ensure the achievement of the above commitments, the organisation has implemented an environmental management system which satisfies the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001. Cavendish Networks have been Registered for BS EN ISO14001 with BSI since December 2015.
